

ARMADILLO RACES

The racing area is contained in a 10' x 20' plexiglas pen, which allows guests to have constant viewing access. Between races, Armadillo Wranglers are available to answer questions (and believe me, there will be questions aplenty about the fascinating State mascot). Your guests will be surprised and delighted with **ARMADILLO RACES** providing lots of laughs and tall tales.

Armadillo sightings in Texas are quite common, and Speed Bump and his fellow racers have been spotted at events for clients such as Baylor University, American Cancer Society Cattle Baron's Ball, Hillwood Development, Microsoft, Mercedes and the AT&T Cotton Bowl Classic. Races have been run in hotels, restaurants, bars, event facilities, convention centers, back yards and parking lots from the Red River to the Gulf of Mexico.
